## LENT 2022

### **2<sup>nd</sup> March 2022 - Ash Wednesday**

Ashes will be blessed and distributed  
during the Masses at **8.20am and 6.30pm**

Lent is an opportunity to spend some extra time each day in peace & quiet to pray for our needs and the needs of others. There will be *Stations of the Cross* on Friday evenings at **7.00pm**. The church will be open one hour before each Mass, perhaps for people to spend some time in private prayer. In preparation for Easter, please try to attend an extra Mass & Devotions each week during Lent to help deepen our prayer & spiritual life. **Ash Wednesday** marks the beginning of the Season of Lent. It is a season of penance, reflection & fasting which prepares us for Christ's Resurrection on Easter Sunday, through which we attain Redemption. The Church reminds us all of the disciplines that help us to live the Christian life in the World. The practises of prayer, of fasting and of almsgiving are the focus not only of the Lenten season, but also of every day of our lives. Lent is our reminder. Now, and every day, is the day of salvation, the day of living the life of faith. Personal and communal prayer leads us out of our narrow selves into the light of the Lord. Fasting from food, drink, television & the pursuit of our own agenda opens us to the encounter with other people. Almsgiving, sharing what we have with others - be it money, time, assistance, patience, consideration - brings blessings on humanity. We are fellow workers with Christ. Daily conversion to the Lord fits us to join in with the reconciliation of the World.
